$$\begin{aligned}8 \times 1 &= 8 \\8 \times 2 &= 16 \\8 \times 3 &= 24 \\8 \times 4 &= 32 \\8 \times 5 &= 40 \\8 \times 6 &= 48 \\8 \times 7 &= 56 \\8 \times 8 &= 64 \\8 \times 9 &= 72 \\8 \times 10 &= 80\end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned}8 \times 11 &= 88 \\8 \times 12 &= 96 \\8 \times 13 &= 104 \\8 \times 14 &= 112 \\8 \times 15 &= 120 \\8 \times 16 &= 128 \\8 \times 17 &= 136 \\8 \times 18 &= 144 \\8 \times 19 &= 152 \\8 \times 20 &= 160\end{aligned}$$
